Communication regarding Deerfield Response to Covid-19 April 29th – Update # 6

To our residents,

I hope everyone is doing well. Based on the announcement of state and local officials, we are pleased to announce the reopening of some of our amenities, with a few restrictions for phase 1. We will continue to reopen other amenities as it is safe to do so, and in compliance with local and state law, and our insurance company.

The following facilities will open effective May 1s:

- Tennis courts (Only 4 persons to a court, no guests)
- Pickleball courts (Only 2 persons to a half court, no guests)
- Basketball court (For shooting only, no game play and no guests)
- Baseball field (4 persons on field maximum, no game play and no guests)
- Volleyball court (4 persons per match and no guests)

Note – These facilities can be used so long as the necessary precautions are maintained to reduce the transmission of COVID-19 and to minimize in-person contact with people who are not in the same household. This responsibility is of each resident using the amenity. The Association will cause to remove or close an amenity, if resident(s) not exercising social distancing and/or taking necessary precautions. Guests are defined as persons not living in Deerfield.

The following facilities remain <u>closed</u> until further notice:

- Clubhouse & Annex
- Meeting rooms
- Exercise equipment *
- Playground equipment (both parks) *
- Park benches
- Restrooms
- SAYOR pool use only
- Pool with lifeguards on duty
