



## Among the usual business of every meeting, we adopted our annual fiscal budget ending March 31, 2006. Contact any MUD136 board member for details.

- Last newsletter we asked residents to comment on a proposal for new payment options, payment of water/sewer bills by credit card, online payment, at grocery stores and check by phone. Our response was light but the overwhelming majority did not think the added expense was worth the convenience the service offered. So we tabled the proposal for some time in the future and will offer the options again at a latter date. Comments?

- 3. Changing the time and date of the District meetings.
