

Residential Trash Reminders...

Please know that there is a 15 bag limit in regards to yard debris per service day. Anything over this limit must be negotiated between the home owner and Texas Trash Service 281-888-3688 Hours of Operation 7am-7pm Office hours 8am-5pm

Pick-up days are Tuesday and Friday. **Please** do not put your trash out until Monday evening or Thursday evening.

Nothing but water should go down our storm drains.

Please make certain that the grass/yard clippings along curbs are bagged. In case of a

heavy rain, these clippings will be swept into the sewer system and block the runoff water; which in turn will flood our streets.



Along with a Rabies tag for ID, the most important is a tag with owner's phone #...since vets are closed on Sat. afternoon and all day Sundays. A tag with a cell # is the best because the cell phone is usually with the owner when he is not home..

By the time you read this article, you will have received your first water bill from our new operating company, Municipal Operations & Consulting, Inc (MOC). Important: If you make payments using automatic bank account debit, you must make new arrangements with MOC. More information concerning this is available on their website www.municipalops.com . It has come to our attention that a fire hydrant in Deerfield was opened to let water out, apparently so that children could play in it. The hydrants are owned by the District. Unauthorized opening of them constitutes tampering with government property. The removal of water constitutes the criminal offense of theft as defined in section 31.03 of the Texas Penal Code. Only our operator, MOC, is authorized to open hydrants, which MOC will do periodically to flush them. MOC is authorized to sell water from the hydrants to contractors who have a need for water. A temporary meter is installed on the hydrant and the contractor is subsequently billed for the actual gallons used. If you observe water being removed from an unmetered hydrant, please contact MOC (281-367-5511), as well as the Constable's office (281-463-6666).

Also, please be aware that the hydrants are going to be repainted this summer with a heavy duty paint that is hard to remove from clothes or the hair of your pet. Just one more reason to stay away from hydrants.

If you have questions or comments concerning this or any other of the District's activities, come to the next monthly meeting, which will be held on Thursday, August 9 at the Rec Center beginning at 6PM.

Spraying Schedule For Mosquitoes

Basic spraying of the subdivision, will be once a week, between Thursday and Sunday. starting after 9:00 PM, ending before 6:00 AM, weather permitting. Spraying will end the first weekend of November..

Larvicide treatment of the storm drains on a monthly basis April - October, weather permitting.

Green Belt fogging as needed April - October, weather permitting.

Chemicals used are free of carcinogenics and safe to be used around pets and children. However, don't let children run behind the spray trucks breathing the fumes, that would not be good for anyone.


