Trash Update – March 19th

To our residents,

Let me assure everyone that Friday's trash pickup will happen as usual.

However, there are additional guidelines until further notice for the safety of our trash personnel. Place all waste in <u>plastic bags</u> and <u>tied off</u> to avoid any direct contact with the garbage. Bags can be grocery <u>store bags</u> or <u>normal size kitchen bags</u>, placed inside your trash can. Be sure each bag is <u>tied off</u>. Continue to bundle branches as you have been. Clippings do not have to be in bags, although recommended.

Please continue to place your recycling loose in your container. However, if anyone in your household is exhibiting symptoms of any transmissible illness, please place recyclables in plastic bags and dispose of with your regular garbage.

Please adhere to these rules if you want your trash picked up. I need your help to be sure everyone is informed. If you see your neighbor not complying to this, they may not have received the communication, and I'm sure they would appreciate if you would let them know.
