

SAYOR Program Swim Rules

- **Access to Pool Area**

- Pool area is to be locked at all times, and the gate must be closed and ensured that it is locked after each use.
- Each person must enter using their personal SAYOR access, currently a 6-digit PIN reader.
- No tailgating unless by immediate family for whom you are accepting responsibility and liability.
- Pool use is restricted to residents who are part of the SAYOR Program.
- ⊖ It is recommended to have a buddy to enter the pool area during SAYOR. A minor participant (under 16) must be accompanied by an adult participant (18 or older), who must remain in the pool area.
- No parties are allowed during SAYOR Program Swim pool hours.
- Unauthorized participants or non-participants using the pool are trespassing and will be prosecuted.
- Swim Pool bathrooms will generally be available, but if closed, use the Recreation Center bathrooms via access card.
- Participants cannot use the pool if water temperature falls below 72 degrees, and it is their responsibility not to enter the pool. DVCA may close the pool if temperature falls below this temperature for most of the day. Program will be available until November 1st, unless extended by the Board.

- **Safety Rules**

- The pool will be closed at any time it is deemed necessary by DVCA in order to safeguard the health, safety, and well-being of all persons in the pool.
- There is a 911 Emergency phone located on the front side of the Pool House and the SEAL number will be posted to help with any non-life-threatening emergencies or issues.
- All posted rules in the Pool area continue to apply during SAYOR, but SAYOR Program Rules supersede the posted rules during SAYOR times.
- It is the full responsibility of the parents/guardian to supervise their children at all times.
- The diving board and deep end are closed and off limits.
- No diving allowed off the deck.
- No rowdy or unruly behavior is allowed in the pool or pool area (ie. horseplay, fighting, etc.)
- Only individual floatation devices are allowed and cannot be used as a substitute for adult supervision.
- No large floats, rafts or animal rafts allowed.
- Only soft sponge balls allowed in pool area.
- No person with open wounds is permitted in the pool.
- No alcohol is allowed in the pool area during SAYOR Program.
- Incontinent swimmers must wear a swim diaper or leak proof plastic pants.
- A participant is a Member enrolled in the SAYOR program and listed on the General Release and Waiver of Liability. A participant that is under the age of 16 must always have an adult buddy with them.
- Trash must be discarded in the trash cans provided or taken out when leaving.
- All items brought in must be taken out when leaving the pool area.

- **Enforcement**

- The rules will be strictly enforced, and the penalties may include removal from the SAYOR program
- DVCA will inform the resident of any SAYOR violation and/or penalty.

I have read and agree to the rules above. I will communicate these rules to my family members prior to entering pool area. These rules are additional to the non-SAYOR pool rules agreed by you.
